Ensure Salvation


# Revisit your heart / Self-examination

*For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light.*


If you are here, transitioning will be tough without someone disciplining you. Backsliding is very probable. People of God we must be aware to ensure we care for the body and not just our own salvation.
